

Pool Guardian Quick Start Guide



1

Begin charging your floating pool unit. We recommend 6 hours initially. Charge cable is included and connects to the charge port on the orange bulkhead.

Plug in home unit and ensure that you have a yellow flashing light. When the unit is flashing it means it is ready for provisioning to your home network.

Go to the App Store or Google Play and search for “Aridea”. When you first launch the app you will be presented with an option to sign up. Follow onscreen and email prompts to complete the registration process.

Once registered successfully you can click Add New Device. If it discovers your device click join, if not click “Go to Settings” and manually connect to the WIFI SSID of your new device (Aridea Pool Unit – XXXX). Choose or add your home Wi-Fi network when prompted. The app will advise when connected. Simply choose all default settings after it connects to complete provisioning. Once successfully connected the system the LED will begin to pulse or “breathe” slowly.

Once the pool unit has been charged you are ready to setup the floating pool unit. Click the power button as depicted in the photo (note that the button may be counter-intuitive, off is depressed). Once powered on you should see the signal and battery display in the app. You can arm and disarm easily from the app.
